Dame Margaret Hodge was a Minister in the Governments of Tony Blair and Gordon Brown, holding portfolios in the Departments of Education, Work and Pensions, Business, and Culture. She was the first Children's Minister (2003-2005). In 2010 Dame Margaret Hodge became the first elected Chair of the Public Accounts Committee and its first female Chair.
